Her distinctive blend of blues and gothic country creates a hauntingly beautiful sound. Her latest release, <i>A Southern Gothic</i>, will transport you to another time and place, where the moving sounds of the South will fill your soul.</p>	<p><b>Andrina Turenne (She/Her)   Manitoba – Roots/Americana</b> Andrina Turenne is an incredibly talented Franco-Manitoban Métis artist with over two decades of experience in the music industry. Her voice has graced over 50 albums and she even won a coveted Juno award with her former band Chic Gamine. Turenne has just released her debut solo album, <i>Bold as Logs</i>.</p>	<p><b>Arny Margret (She/Her)   Iceland – Folk</b> Arny Margret is a 21-year-old singer-songwriter from Iceland. She has gained critical acclaim and was nominated as the newcomer at the Icelandic Music awards in 2022. Her debut album, <i>They Only Talk About The Weather</i>, explores her coming-of-age journey and touches on loneliness, existentialism and her relationships growing up.</p>
<p><b>Aysanabee (He/Him)   Sandy Lake First Nation – Alternative</b> Aysanabee is a Toronto-based Juno-nominated multi-instrumentalist, producer and singer-songwriter from Sandy Lake First Nation. He began creating music during the pandemic and his debut album, <i>Watin</i>, features music that includes the voice of his grandfather. His hypnotic and melodic sound has been compared to artists such as Bon Iver and Sam Smith.</p>	<p><b>Balaklava Blues (Group)   Ontario – Folk Noir/EDM</b> Balaklava Blues is a Ukrainian folk-noir band that blends traditional polyphonic music with personal stories and sounds of revolution and war. Their live shows incorporate stunning visuals that blend folk motifs with contemporary expressions of power, vulnerability and trauma. They released their album, <i>Let Me Out</i>, in 2022.</p>	<p><b>Bella White (She/Her)   British Columbia – Americana</b> Bella White is a 22-year-old singer and multi-instrumentalist. Her albums showcase her old-time musicality and contemporary lyrical perspective as she documents her coming-of-age experiences in real-time. White grew up on classic country and old-time music, which her Virginia-native father introduced to her. She released her album, <i>Among Other Things</i>, in 2023.</p>
<p><b>Black Belt Eagle Scout (She/Her/They/Them)   Oregon – Experimental</b> Black Belt Eagle Scout's a.k.a. Katherine Paul's 2023 album, <i>The Land, The Water, The Sky</i>, is a celebration of lineage, strength and returning to their ancestral lands. Her songs reflect a journey home and each one is a love letter to Indigenous strength and healing. Katherine Paul has channeled that feeling of being held. The power of the land is woven throughout the album.</p>	<p><b>Black Opry Revue (Group)   Various – Americana/Country/Roots</b> The Black Opry Revue is a vibrant community for Black artists, fans, and industry professionals in country, Americana, blues, and folk music. It's a rallying cry for marginalized communities, a place to amplify the work of Black country artists, and a network to build a sense of community and bypass racist institutions. It was founded in April 2021 by Holly G.</p>	<p><b>Bola Oriyomi (She/Her)   Manitoba – Family/Storyteller</b> Bola Oriyomi is a Nigerian storyteller and cultural performer who has been performing for over 25 years. She draws inspiration from traditional African folktales and her life experiences to create engaging stories and performances. Bola has performed globally and is the founder of Ariya Afrika Cultural Group, a contemporary African dance group. Her work has been featured on CBC Radio and local TV stations.</p>
<p><b>Buenrostro (Group)   Mexico – WorldBeat</b> Buenrostro is a dynamic multicultural musical project hailing from Milpa Alta, Mexico City. Inspired by their ancestors' traditional rhythms and worldwide genres, they bring an innovative approach to their music that has taken them to stages both in Mexico and abroad. With each new song, Buenrostro transforms, defying traditional sonority with fresh and daring touches. Their music is a vibrant celebration of culture and creativity.</p>	<p><b>Buffalo Nichols (He/Him)   Wisconsin - Blues</b> Since his earliest infatuations with guitar, Buffalo Nichols has asked himself the same question: How can I bring the blues of the past into the future? It was a globetrotting trip through West Africa and Europe during a creative down period that began to reveal the answer. He released his debut self-titled album in 2021.</p>	<p><b>Castlemoon Theatre (Group)   Manitoba – Children's Theatre</b> Castlemoon is theatre for young audiences specializing in puppetry and workshops. They've created stories inspired by children's literature since 2007, with music, soundscape and visual worlds made by composers and visual artists. Dirk Powell is an accomplished multi-instrumentalist who has played with many famous musicians such as Joan Baez, Lorette Lynn and Eric Clapton, while Cedric Watson is a four-time Grammy nominated fiddler, accordionist and songwriter who is leading the new generation of Cajun and Creole musicians.</p>	<p><b>Charley Crockett (He/Him)   Texas – Americana/Country</b>          Charley Crockett is a rising star in the music industry with a unique sound that blends traditional country, blues and soul. His heartfelt lyrics and dynamic stage presence are sure to capture your heart and leave you wanting more. His most recent album <i>The Man From Waco</i> was released in fall of 2022 and has become one of his most listened to albums.</p>
<p><b>Charlotte Cornfield (She/Her)   Ontario – Alternative/Indie/Folk</b>          Charlotte Cornfield's <i>Highs in the Minuses</i> is a deeply personal album that captures the energy of live performance. The folk-rock symphony, recorded with friends and colleagues, reflects each song's feeling. Cornfield's lyrics convey heartbreak, self-discovery, and new love with raw and shambolic commonality. Despite its brutal honesty, <i>Highs in the Minuses</i> invites listeners to feel alongside Cornfield, presenting details like a documentary.</p>	<p><b>DJ Shub presents War Club (He/Him)   Ontario – PowWowStep/Electronic/DJ</b>          DJ Shub, a Mohawk of the Six Nations of the Grand River in Canada, is known as the Godfather of PowWowStep. His latest album <i>War Club</i> (2020) was critically acclaimed and featured collaborations with other Indigenous and BIPOC artists. DJ Shub won the 2022 JUNO award for Contemporary Indigenous Artist of the Year.</p>	<p><b>Dongyang Gozupa (Group)   South Korea – Rock/Korean Classical</b>          Dongyang Gozupa is a Korean progressive rock band that incorporates traditional Korean music with Yanggeum (Korean hammered dulcimer), bass and percussion. Their music is difficult to categorize, blending elements of progressive and post-rock with traditional music and are known for their strong, speedy performance.</p>
<p><b>Emmylou Harris (She/Her)   Alabama – Singer-Songwriter</b>          Legendary American singer-songwriter, EmmyLou Harris, is a highly respected artist whose career spans 40 years. With 14 Grammy Awards, three CMA Awards, four Americana Awards and an induction into the Country Music Hall of Fame she is one of the most decorated artists in the industry. Her music spans multiple genres, including country, folk and Americana.</p>	<p><b>Evan Redsky (He/Him)   Ontario – Americana/Folk</b>          Evan Redsky is a First Nations songwriter from Mississauga First Nation, currently residing in Toronto. His latest album, <i>Oblivion</i>, combines traditional storytelling and poignant commentary on the human condition. Redsky's personal experiences with intergenerational trauma and the injustices faced by Indigenous peoples in Canada inform his music and advocacy work.</p>	<p><b>Faye Webster (She/Her)   Georgia – Singer-Songwriter</b>          Faye Webster is a young, talented songwriter from Atlanta, Georgia. Her music is infused with raw emotion, which she captures by writing from the heart and then heading straight to the studio to record the next day. Her signature style blends intimate, whisper-quiet vocals with the unmistakable sound of musicians playing together in the same room. In 2022, she released her highly anticipated album, <i>Car Therapy Sessions</i>. Get swept away by her soulful melodies and heart-wrenching lyrics.</p>
<p><b>Field Guide (He/Him)   Manitoba – Alternative</b>          Dylan MacDonald, better known as Field Guide, crafts captivating soundscapes with lush textures and captivating melodies in his self-titled sophomore album. His songs capture the perfect balance between darkness and optimism, exploring themes of love, finding joy in melancholy, and embracing uncertainty. In 2023, he released a stripped-down, reimagined version of the album titled <i>Field Guide (Tape Redux)</i> that showcases his raw talent and artistry.</p>	<p><b>Finjan (Group)   Manitoba – Klezmer</b>          Finjan's performance debut was at the 1983 Winnipeg Folk Festival giving them 40 years of experience! Finjan will transport you to the heart of klezmer music with their traditional dance favourites, original compositions and Yiddish theatre hits. Get ready to dance because you won't be able to sit still for this one!</p>	<p><b>Fire &amp; Smoke (Duo)   Manitoba/Quebec – Folks/Roots</b>          Fire &amp; Smoke is an enchanting bilingual folk-roots duo, featuring the captivating storytelling of Claire Morrison and Daniel Péloquin-Hopfner. With their haunting melodies and intimate lyrics, they have been honored with numerous awards, including the prestigious CBC/Radio-Canada Phonogramme Prize and a coveted spot on CBC Canada Live.</p>

We aspire to be a supportive, productive environment in which diverse children, artists, audiences and participants can be inspired, grow, create and evolve.</p>	<p><b>Joe Rainey (He/Him)   Wisconsin – Pow Wow/Experimental</b>          Joe Rainey is a passionate Pow Wow singer from Red Lake Ojibwe in Minneapolis. He learned the traditional singing style as a child and later formed his own drum group. Rainey's latest album, <i>Niineta</i>, is a groundbreaking work that transforms traditional Pow Wow sounds into fresh, experimental tracks, produced in collaboration with Andrew Broder.</p>	<p><b>Julian Taylor (He/Him)   Ontario – Roots</b>          Julian Taylor is a self-managed musician, singer-songwriter and label owner from Toronto. He has established himself as one of Canada's greatest troubadours over his 20-plus year career, earning multiple award nominations for his 2020 LP <i>The Ridge</i> and his new album <i>Beyond the Reservoir</i> builds on the soul-folk sound and autobiographical themes first explored in <i>The Ridge</i>.</p>
<p><b>Kacy &amp; Clayton (Duo)   Saskatchewan – Country/Folk</b>          Kacy Anderson and Clayton Linthicum are second cousins who grew up in the rural town of Wood Mountain, Saskatchewan. Their music is a beautiful blend of rare country, blues, and English folk rock, inspired by their upbringing. Their album, <i>Carrying On</i>, features live takes with minimal overdubs, giving it a raw and authentic feel that is hard to come by in today's music scene. Listening to their music is like taking a trip down memory lane, back to a simpler time and place filled with warmth, nostalgia, and soul.</p>	<p><b>Kelsey Waldon (She/Her)   Tennessee – Alternative/Country</b>          Kentucky-bred singer/songwriter/guitarist Kelsey Waldon released her fourth album, <i>No Regular Dog</i>, in 2022. Their sound is a fusion of traditional Mongolian instruments alongside electric bass and drums. They transport listeners back to ancient times, telling tales of Mongol fighters, champions, horses and famous battles. The album was inspired by Sonic Boom's idea of creating song-length loops from snippets of old favourites he rediscovered after moving to Portugal. <i>Reset</i> is a masterpiece that brilliantly addresses the challenges of life and provides a path to a brighter future.</p>	<p><b>Pierre Kwenders (He/Him)   Quebec – Singer-Songwriter</b> Pierre Kwenders is a talented musician, songwriter, and DJ from Congo, who resides in Montreal. <p><b>Shane Cook &amp; The Woodchippers   Ontario – Trad Music</b> Shane Cook &amp; The Woodchippers create a modern, lively sound that draws from traditional music, song and dance of Ontario, as well as folk, Celtic, roots, country, contemporary and jazz. Led by Canadian and U.S. National fiddle champion Shane Cook, the group features multi-instrumentalists, singers and step dancers.</p>	<p><b>Sierra Ferrell   West Virginia – Alternative/Americana/Bluegrass</b> Sierra Ferrell is a singer, songwriter and multi-instrumentalist from West Virginia whose music defies categorization. Her song "Now You See It" from the EP of the same name won the 2022 RTE Radio 1 'Best Original Folk Song' award. O'Neill is a force to be reckoned with in the world of music.</p>	<p><b>Tamikrest (Group)   Republic of Mali – Ishumar Rock/Tuareg Blues</b> Tamikrest (meaning "junction," "connection," "knot," and "coalition" in the Tamasheq language) is a group of members from Mali, Niger, Algeria and France. Though their music takes root in Ishumar Rock or Tuareg Blues, it borrows from various international influences and neighbouring cultures. Tamikrest aims to make Tamasheq poetry and culture accessible to the wider world through their songs.</p>	<p><b>The Campbell Brothers (Group)   New York – Sacred Steel Gospel</b> Based in New York and playing for almost 20 years, The Campbell Brothers create a special mix of African-American Holiness-Pentecostal music. The band includes Chuck Campbell on pedal steel guitar, Phil Campbell on electric guitar, Carlton Campbell on drums and Daric Bennett on bass guitar. They are joined by Denise Brown, Tiffany Godette and/or Joyce "Cinnamon" Brown, whose powerful gospel vocals add energy and emotion to the group. These highly regarded DJs and parents of two bring the energy of the club at kid-friendly volumes to deliver world-class sets that seamlessly mix hip-hop, pop, Motown, funk, soul, deep cuts and mega hits.</p>	<p><b>The War On Drugs   California/Pennsylvania – Rock</b></p> <p>The War on Drugs is an American rock band praised for their ability to bridge the gap between underground and mainstream. Their album, <i>A Deeper Understanding</i>, won the 2018 Grammy for Best Rock Album. They released their fifth studio album, <i>I Don't Live Here Anymore</i>, in 2021 to critical acclaim and were nominated for a BRIT Award.</p>
<p><b>Two Runner   California - Roots</b></p> <p>Two Runner is a modern folk duo consisting of songwriter Paige Anderson and fiddle player Emilie Rose. Anderson grew up touring with her family bluegrass band, while Rose has a deep understanding and love for folk music traditions. Together, they bring strong songwriting, vocal harmonies and musicianship on clawhammer banjo, flat-picking guitar and old-time fiddle.</p>	<p><b>Vance Joy   Australia – Folk Pop</b></p> <p>Vance Joy is an Australian indie folk singer-songwriter who began his career playing the Melbourne open-mic scene. He gained success with his catchy folk-pop single "Riptide" which led him to sign with Atlantic Records. Joy released new music in 2021 with the x2 Platinum track "Missing Piece" which landed on his 2022 full-length, <i>In Our Own Sweet Time</i>.</p>	<p><b>Walking Wolf Singers &amp; Dancers (Group)   Manitoba – Indigenous Singers &amp; Dancers</b></p> <p>Walking Wolf Singers &amp; Dancers was established over 20 years ago with the goal of not only performing, but also educating people about Indigenous song and dance. The group promotes pride in the Indigenous community and its traditions. Over the years, they have released seven albums, most recently, <i>Walking Wolf Singers (Giving Thanks)</i>.</p>
<p><b>Whitehorse (Duo)   Ontario – Country/Blues</b></p> <p>Whitehorse is a Canadian music duo from Ontario with a unique sound that blends guitar-heavy, harmony-rich genres. The duo's talents as co-authors and collaborators have earned them five consecutive JUNO Award nominations. His exceptional body of work has been widely recognized since winning a JUNO Award, receiving international acclaim and adding a depth and dimension that truly sets him apart.</p>	<p><b>Witch Prophet (She/Her)   Ontario – Jazz/Hip Hop/Soul/R&amp;B</b></p> <p>Witch Prophet is an amazing Canadian singer-songwriter who masterfully blends jazz, hip hop, soul and R&amp;B in her music. Her Polaris Prize-nominated album, <i>DNA Activation</i>, was a powerful exploration of her Ethiopian and Eritrean heritage, released in 2020. Witch Prophet has just released a new soulful and captivating album called <i>Gateway Experience</i> on May 3, 2023.
