The 48th annual Winnipeg Folk Festival is held **July 6-9, 2023** at **Birds Hill Provincial Park** in Manitoba.

Each year we aim to program a very high quality, diverse festival with many genres represented on multiple stages. The festival also programs a family area that hosts a variety of family friendly music and performances.

Planning begins with a priority list that far exceeds the number of artists we can realistically program, and throughout the process we discover more amazing music by keeping our ears and eyes open, attending shows, other festivals and conferences, and talking to colleagues. In addition, a small number of acts are booked through unsolicited submissions each year.
